WEARING OF THE UNIFORM

Memorandum No. 73, 16 November 1943; Memorandum No. 10, 3 February 1944, Memorandum No. 12, 4 February 1944; and paragraph 4, Daily Bulletin No. 33, all issued by this headquarters, and all pertaining to the wearing of the uniform, are hereby rescinded and the following substituted in their stead.

1. PASS, FURLOUGH AND LEAVE

a. Enlisted Men:

(1) Class "A" Uniform No. 1, consisting of trousers, wool od; blouse; shirt, cotton or woolen od; necktie; cap, garrison; shoes, service or shoes, garrison low quarter; overshoes, arctic, if required; and overcoat, if required.

(2) Class "A" Uniform No. 2, consisting of trousers, ski; gaiters, ski; boots, ski or ski-mountain; blouse; shirt, cotton or woolen od; necktie; cap, garrison or ski; and overcoat if required.

Note 1. The trousers, wool od may be worn in lieu of trousers, ski, with gaiters, ski and boots, ski or ski-mountain.

Note 2. In view of the fact that but one (1) pair of trousers, ski, gaiters, ski and boots, ski or ski-mountain are issued to each individual, commanders concerned will take steps to insure that Class "A" Uniform No. 2 is worn only when the aforementioned articles are in a clean and presentable condition. In no case will the leggings, canvas, be worn in lieu of the gaiters, ski.

Note 3. When the cap, ski, is worn as a part of Class "A" Uniform No. 2, steps will be taken to insure that it is in a clean and presentable condition.
